Norm Miller is a Professor of Real Estate at the University of San Diego. For much of his academic career he was at the University of Cincinnati as Academic and Center Director. He received his Ph.D. from the Ohio State University. He is active on the Editorial Board of several national/international journals and a past President of the American Real Estate Society. Known for his pioneering work on the economics of green and sustainable real estate, he edits the Journal of Sustainable Real Estate. Dr. Miller worked as V.P. of Analytics at CoStar, and as a research principal with <u>Collateral Analytics</u>. He is also on the advisory boards of Pathfinders, Measurabl, and Verdani. His most recent book, *Commercial Real Estate Analysis and Investment*, is in its third edition and is the leading graduate real estate textbook in the world. He is currently a <u>Homer Hoyt Land Use Institute</u> Faculty and Board member, where he is involved with some premier thought leaders among academics and industry professionals in a think tank setting. He has worked with as an expert on several valuation disputes in behalf of local county governments.
